Introduction

If you hate spending ages setting up this fantastic game, then this insert might be for you.

This insert houses all game components from the standard version of the game (ie: no deluxe components). It does support sleeved cards, and the box lid will shut completely.

Materials

5mm foam core. Because the 5mm foam core I'm using is actually 6mm (including the paper on either side) I've allowed for 6mm in all places.

You'll need a box cutter and an exacto knife.

I like to design things that slot in together, rather than butting up against each other. So the slicing in this is a touch fiddly at times.

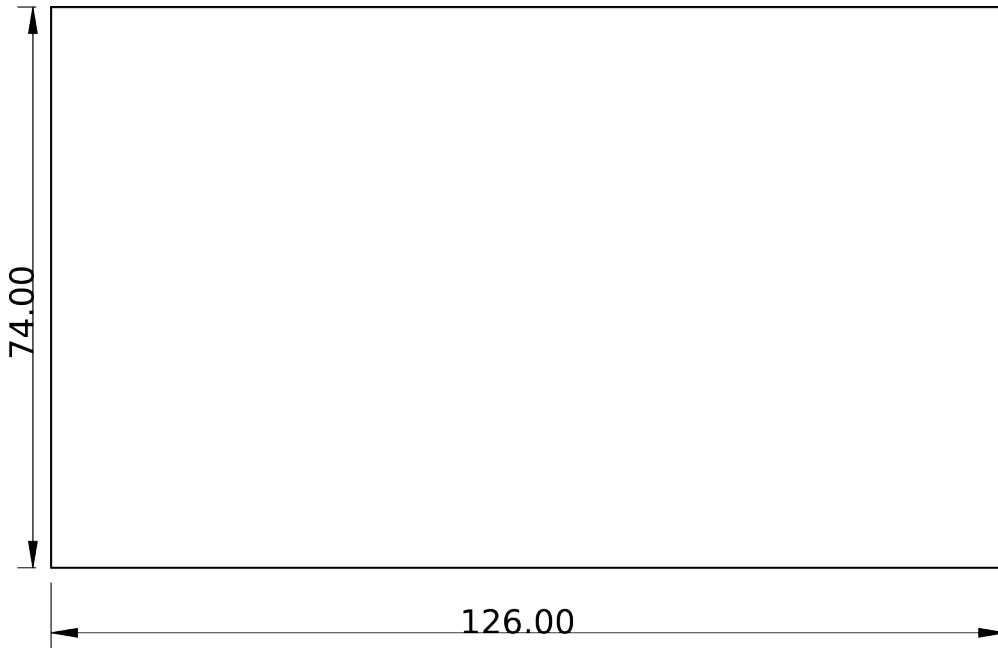
Instructions

The plans printed from here should be at 1 to 1 scale if you've printed at 100% with no scaling.

To be sure, you can check the measurements on the sample below.

Once you know that the sizing is correct, you can use the plans as cutting stencils and either glue them to your foam board, or maybe blue-tak them in place.
